OVERVIEW:

The BMW Driving Experience for the Southeast Regional Angel Capital Association meeting is scheduled for late afternoon on October 20th, 2010. The event is designed to give participants a one-of-a-kind opportunity to experience the thrill of driving high-performance BMWs on the world renowned [BMW Performance Center](#) track under the watchful eyes of professional driving instructors. The event will create lasting memories in an “edutainment” environment.

PROGRAM:

This special program has your guests arriving at the BMW Performance Center by 4:20PM for registration and introduction to the professional instructors along with a review of the driving sessions.

Around 4:45 the group will begin participating in two (2) exciting driving exercises designed to be “fast and furious” and lots of fun. These sessions could include a Performance Drive which offers guests the opportunity to drive a variety of BMW vehicles, a Rat Race, or a Wet/Dry race or timed laps. LOCATION:

Optional transportation to and from the BMW Performance Center will be provided to those who register. For those of you who may be driving, the BMW Performance Center (PC) is conveniently located about 2 miles off I-85 in Greer, South Carolina. From GSP take I-85 north to exit 60 (SC Hwy 101-Greer/Woodruff) and turn north towards Greer. Go past the entrance to the BMW Manufacturing plant which will be on your left and proceed about a mile to the Performance Center which you will see on your right. Turn into the facility and park in either the front or the far side.

ATTIRE:

Casual attire is recommended. No open toe or open heel shoes please.
