Angel Capital Association Announces Inaugural Silvertip Award Winners

Honoring entrepreneurs for innovation, shifting markets, and fast growth

Boston, MA April 5, 2011 - The Angel Capital Association (ACA), the trade association of leading angel investment groups in North America, announced the inaugural winners of the ACA Silvertip Awards at the 2011 ACA Summit in Boston.

The ACA, in partnership with HP and PricewaterhouseCoopers (PWC), launched these awards to bring international attention of investors, strategic partners, and potential acquirers to the top angel-backed companies and their supporting angel groups.

"The Silvertip Awards honor the most outstanding and successful ACA member portfolio companies throughout North America," said Marianne Hudson, executive director of ACA. "These are companies that received angel investment and put that money to work developing disruptive technologies, creating new markets, demonstrating extreme innovation, or simply scaling up and growing very rapidly."

Quantum Dental Technologies (www.thecanarysystem.com) of Toronto, Ontario, Canada received the Luis Villalobos Award as the most innovative ACA portfolio company in any sector. The sponsoring angel group is Boston Harbor Angels of Boston, MA.

"This award honors Luis Villalobos, a dedicated angel whose curiosity and appetite for original thought and innovation was limitless," said Hudson. "Quantum Dental Technologies' ingenious solution has the potential to change the way dentists everywhere detect tooth decay. That's innovation."

Quantum Dental Technologies' product searches for tooth decay by looking at crystal structure of teeth to find problems when they are early and small enough to be treated and healed without drilling or fillings.

INRange Systems, Inc. (www.inrangesystems.com) of Altoona, PA was named winner of the HP Startup Central Award, which honors the top technology company most likely to create large

new markets or to disrupt large, existing markets. The sponsoring angel group is BlueTree Allied Angels of Pittsburgh, PA.

"INRange Systems is pioneering a whole new category of medical devices," Hudson said. "They have created a new market, providing institutional quality of care in a residential setting."

The INRange Systems device is the first medical device cleared by the FDA for remote medication management. The solution addresses one of the nation's greatest healthcare problems, non-adherence to prescribed timing and dosage of medication and adverse drug events.

HarQen, Inc. (<u>www.harqen.com</u>) of Milwaukee, WI was awarded the PwC Entrepreneurship Award, which recognizes the company most likely to generate the most revenue growth over the next five years. The sponsoring angel group is Phenomenelle Angels Fund of Madison, WI.

"HarQen's voice management platform captures, organizes, and shares voice content," says Hudson. "The company has fifty current clients, negotiated master service agreements with several of the world's largest companies, and is starting to roll out products globally."

The Silvertip Award winners had the opportunity to speak about their companies at the ACA Summit, the largest gathering of angel investors in the world.
